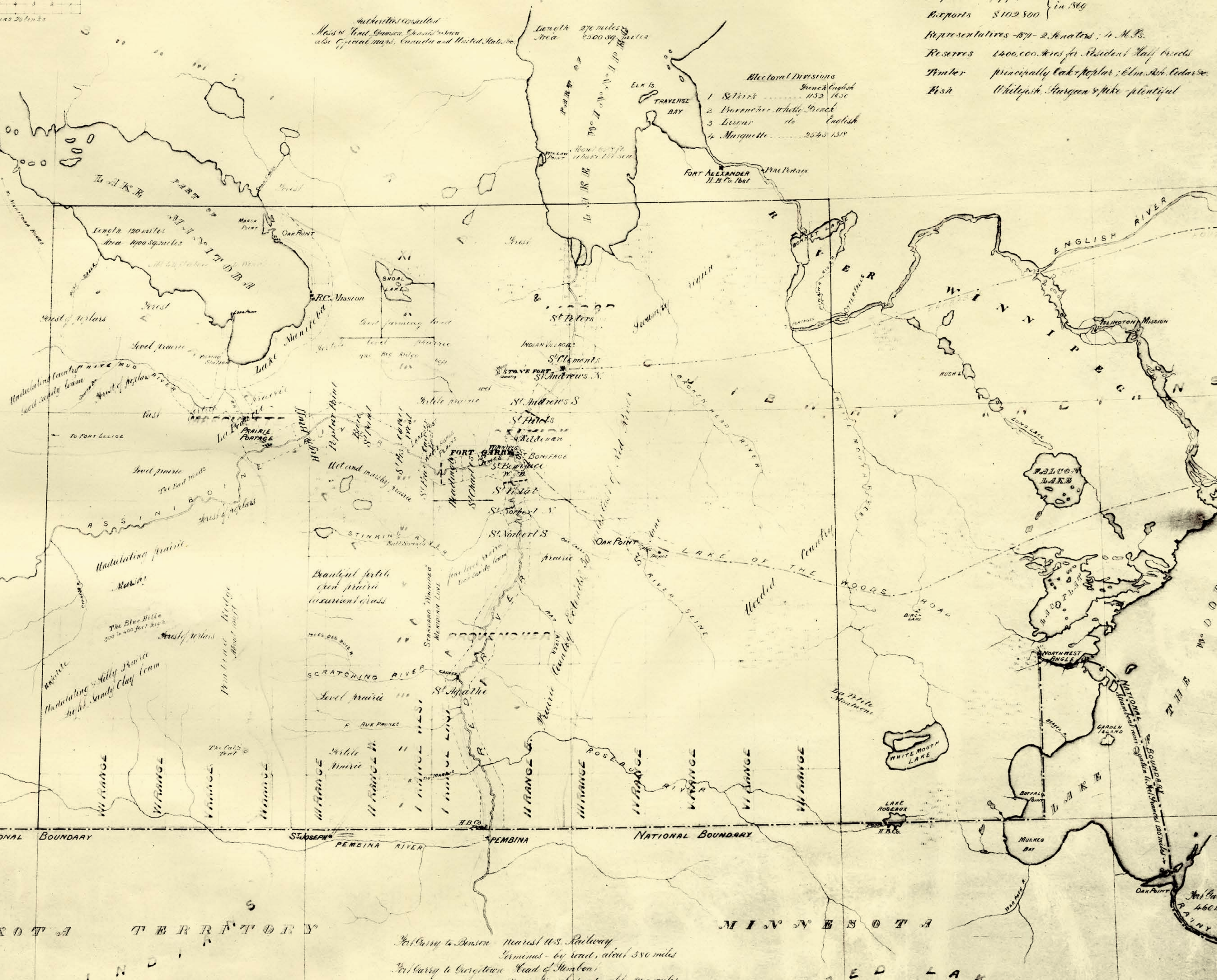


MAP OF THE PROVINCE OF MANITOBA
